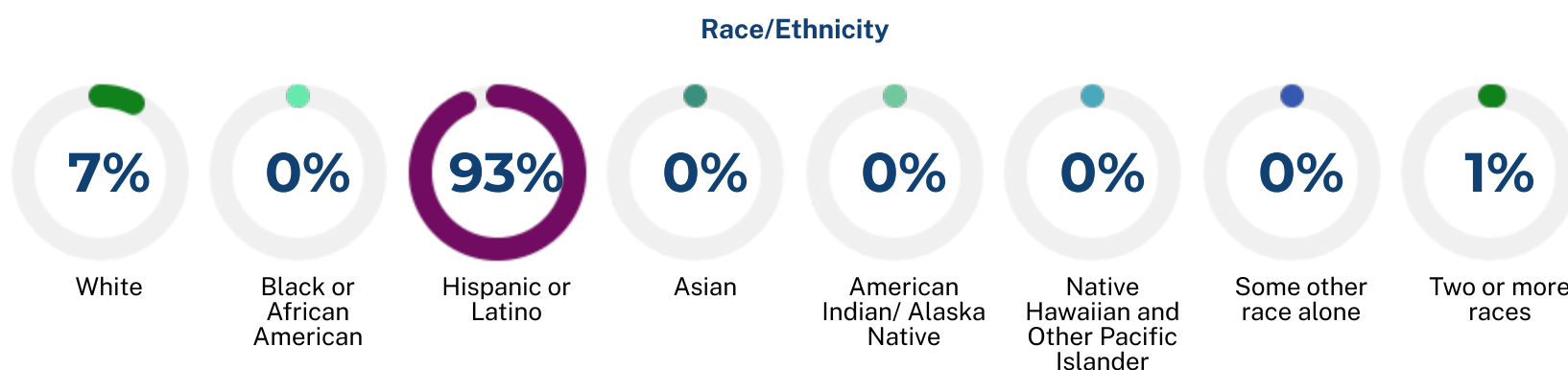

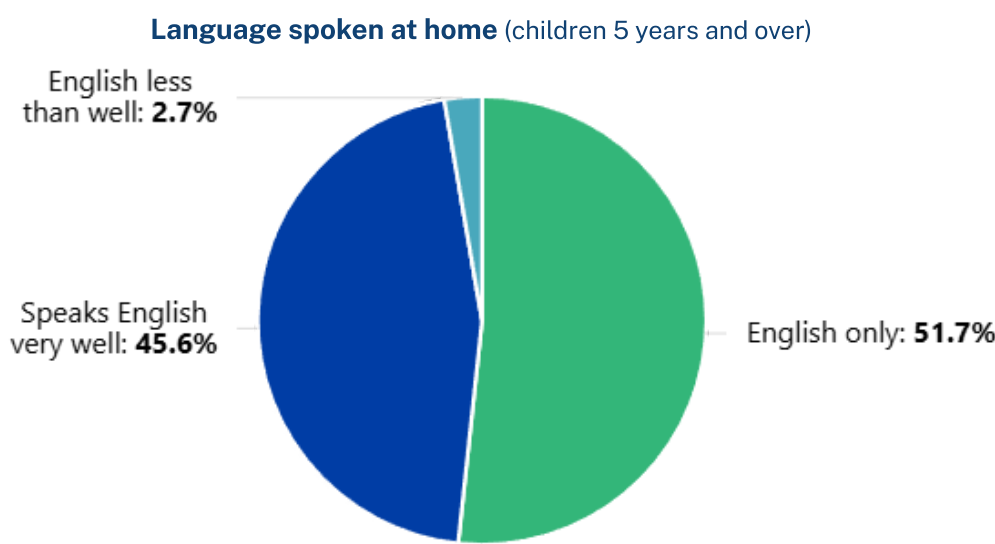

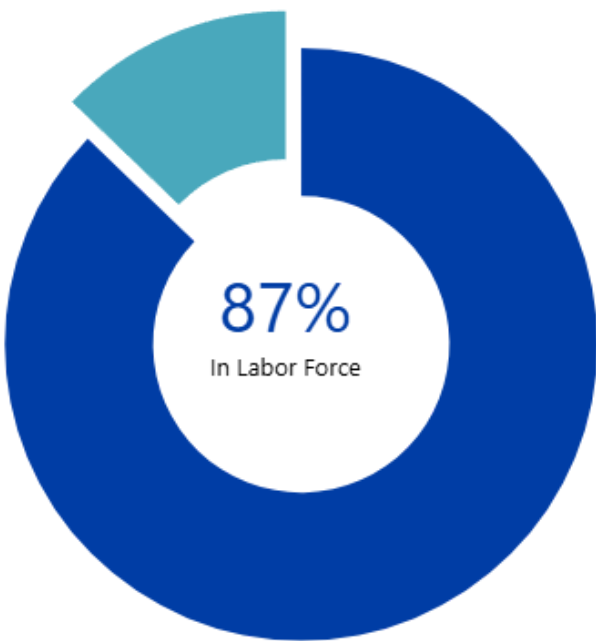

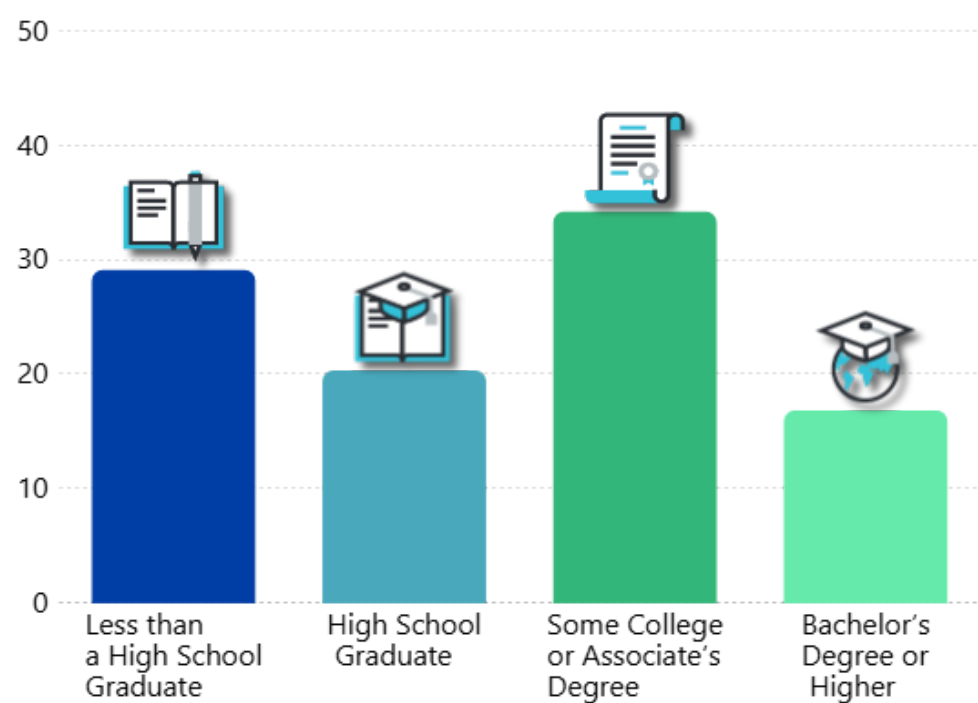

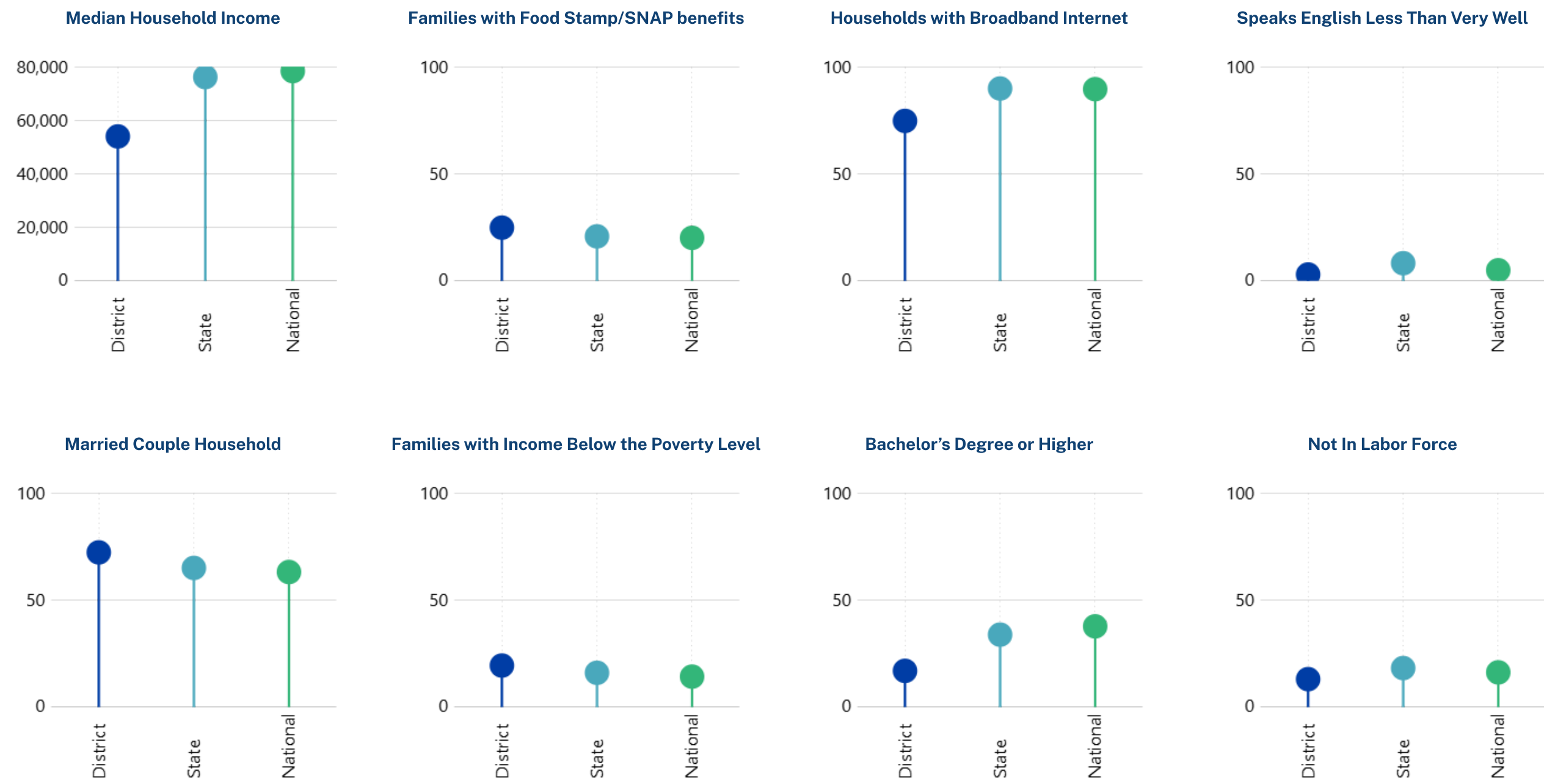
Labor Force Status
